### **Geneva Institute Community Life Standards**

All participants in Geneva Institute activities are required to affirm that they have read the statement of Community Life Standards of the Institute and that they agree to support these standards. In accordance with a biblical commitment to personal development, the Institute makes every effort to administer these standards graciously. Those who demonstrate a desire for growth will find a community of support and encouragement. Students who are consistently unable or unwilling to adhere to these standards of behavior will not be permitted to remain at the Institute.

- Practices specifically forbidden in the Scriptures are not permitted. These include dishonesty, theft, vandalism, fornication, adultery, homosexual behavior, immodest dress, profanity, gossip, and drunkenness.
- Scripture explicitly teaches respect for governmental authority. Members of the Institute community are thus expected to uphold the laws of the local community, the state, and the nation except where those laws may be demonstrably unjust according to Scripture.
- In a Christian academic community, academic dishonesty, including cheating, plagiarism, and misappropriation of library materials or other Institute property, is regarded as a serious violation of biblical standards.
- Practices are undesirable that inhibit a responsible use of talents and resources, or that encourage exposure to demeaning social surroundings. Since the possession and use of pornographic materials, and attendance at questionable performances are of this nature, members of the Institute community will refrain from them, whether in a public or a private setting.

In addition, dual enrollment students will abide by all partnering college standards and maintain good academic standing with the College.

#### **The Honor Code**

The Honor Code is simply stated: "Every student shall be honor bound to refrain from cheating (including plagiarism). Every student shall be honor bound to refrain from stealing. Every student shall be honor bound to refrain from lying. Any violation of this Honor Code can result in dismissal from the Institute."

### **Appendix: Statement of Belief**

For the purpose of student sponsorship, the Geneva Institute has chosen to use the Bryan College Statement of Belief, reprinted here for convenience:<sup>1</sup>

#### We Believe:

- that the holy Bible, composed of the Old and New Testaments, is of final and supreme authority in faith and life, and, being inspired by God, is inerrant in the original writings;
- in God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost, this Trinity being one God, eternally existing in three persons;
- in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ; that He was born of the virgin Mary and begotten of the Holy Spirit;
- that the origin of man was by fiat of God in the act of creation as related in the Book of Genesis; that he was created in the image of God; that he sinned and thereby incurred physical and spiritual death;
- that all human beings are born with a sinful nature, and are in need of a Savior for their reconciliation to God;
- that the Lord Jesus Christ is the only Savior, that He was crucified for our sins, according to the Scriptures, as a voluntary representative and substitutionary sacrifice, and all who believe in Him and confess Him before men are justified on the grounds of His shed blood;
- in the resurrection of the crucified body of Jesus, in His ascension into Heaven, and in "that blessed hope," the personal return to this earth of Jesus Christ, and He shall reign forever; and
- in the bodily resurrection of all persons, judgment to come, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost.
