Romans 3:21-26

[A] <u>But now</u> apart from the Law *the* **righteousness of God has been manifested**, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,

even *the* righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe;

- [B] for there is no distinction; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
 - [C] being justified as a gift by His grace through the <u>redemption</u> which is in Christ Jesus;

[D] whom God displayed publicly

[C'] as a propitiation in His blood through faith.

[B'] *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

[A'] for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time,

so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
